

# Pediatric Emergency Department

From the seriously sick to the critically injured, the Peter J. King Pediatric Emergency Department at Children's – St. Paul is well-equipped to handle whatever may come through the doors. Philanthropic support enabled a full renovation of the emergency department, allowing for more efficient care by reducing wait times and improving patient flow. Our emergency departments see some of the highest volumes in the region – more than 90,000 kids a year – while achieving some of the lowest wait times in the country. Kids in crisis can't wait and thanks to our emergency department redesign, they don't have to.

# WORLD-CLASS CARE IN OUR BACKYARD

With soothing colors, private rooms and staff who specialize in easing fear and anxiety, the emergency department provides a calm and welcoming environment for anyone in need of the very best care.

### Pediatric Trauma Center

When it comes to traumatic injuries, every second counts. UnitedHealthcare® was the catalyst that advanced our pediatric trauma program. Their strategic and financial support accelerated Children's achievement of Level I trauma status in three years instead of ten. As the region's only Level I pediatric trauma center located within a freestanding children's hospital, we receive patients directly from the scene of an incident. From our helipad and ambulance bays, kids have immediate access to specialized trauma bays and the most skilled team of pediatric trauma surgeons, doctors, nurses and specialists – all available 24/7.

### Cardiovascular Care Center

# OPERATION: MAKING KIDS HEALTHY



### The Mother Baby Center

Driven by a vision to help moms and babies receive coordinated care under one roof, The Mother Baby Center came to life through the generous support of our community. From delivery rooms supported by Pat and Ann Ryan to resuscitation rooms, this unique Center leads some of the most innovative areas of care – like treatments for babies needing fetal surgery in the Greg and Jane Goven Family Integrated Operating Room. And, thanks to the leadership of Mike and Ann Ciresi and Mark and Shannon Evenstad, we have developed a fetal care center to ensure babies receive the best care at the earliest moment – even before birth.

And for babies who need a little more care before heading home, the Blackford Family Special Care Nursery provides the perfect place to grow and thrive. Both spaces are close in proximity to postpartum rooms, making it easy for parents to stay involved in their baby's care.

Thanks to the support of so many who believed it was possible to treat both moms and babies in one spot, the tunnel that was once used to transport babies from Abbott Northwestern's labor and delivery rooms to Children's NICU is no longer needed.













Children's was the first hospital in the country to offer private patient rooms in a NICU – allowing babies to bond with their parents. Altogether, Children's has more than 130 beds dedicated to the most advanced services and specialized staff who are leading the nation in neonatal care.

# Neonatal Intensive Care Units (NICU)

Babies who need the most critical care receive treatment in the Level III neonatal intensive care units (NICU), which boast some of the best outcomes in the world. For those who are more stable, the Miller Family Neonatal Intensive Care Unit – Level II and the Lee and Penny Anderson Infant Care Center provide just the level of care they need. These advanced services have long been supported by those who see big futures for our littlest patients.

# Pediatric Intensive Care Units (PICU)

The most critically ill patients require the most highly-specialized care. Through your generosity, the Children's Hospital Association (CHA) PICU and the Pohlad Family Foundation PICU are prepared to help kids through some of the most challenging medical situations. Our PICUs offer advanced treatments, 24/7 in-house pediatric intensivists, and one-on-one nursing care. And 42 private patient rooms allow the entire family to participate in their child's care and ultimately aid in the healing process.

With vitally important equipment overflowing into hallways and patients separated from one another only by curtains, the PICUs were once some of the most uncomfortable spaces. Now, everything and everyone has a place within the four walls of a private patient room.























### Pediatric Neuroscience Center

Bringing our neuroscience care team together in a state-of-the-art center was a priority for donors so that kids could receive the most coordinated care. At the Karen and George Benz Family Pediatric Neuroscience Center, our multi-disciplinary team cares for more neurology, brain tumor and epilepsy patients than any other institution in the region. And the Lee and Penny Anderson Epilepsy Unit is one of only a few units of its kind equipped to treat the most complex epilepsy cases, with some of the best outcomes in the nation.


# MAKING THE HOSPITAL FEEL MORE LIKE HOME














### Fill A Room With Care
