



A Story of Belonging



"Embrace life," is the motto Claire lives by. It is a profound statement coming from a young woman. She is not only a former patient of Florida Hospital, but she was one of the first children to be treated at Florida Hospital Cancer Institute when it opened its doors in 1997.

At the age of four, Claire was diagnosed with Primitive Undifferentiated Sarcoma in her tonsils. The normal steps for chemotherapy were immediately taken. However, the cancer did not respond to the usual treatments. Claire's doctors quickly realized that they needed a new approach in order to save her life. They opted to use radiation; a treatment option that is traumatizing for an adult, let alone a four year old girl.

"The hardest part was fitting in. I was losing my hair and a lot of weight. All I wanted to do at that age was go play with my friends. This was not easy for a preschool kid," explained Claire.

Dr. Cliff Selsky, Claire's doctor at the Florida Hospital Cancer Institute, is a trailblazer in the medical field. To this day, Claire credits him for saving her life and giving her a normal childhood, as well as a bright future.

At the conclusion of kindergarten, Claire's treatments were finished and she went into remission. This was an extremely happy time for her and her family. They still express their appreciation for Florida Hospital. They are grateful for the doctors and staff, which helped to give their daughter life and for the comfort they experienced during one of the scariest times in their lives.

Claire has dedicated her life to giving back to her community. She is currently attending the University of Central Florida as a student athlete, and is a member of the UCF rowing team. She lives every day to the fullest and has a wonderful outlook. She plans to attend Florida Hospital's College of Health Sciences to study nursing. Her dream is to become a pediatric oncology nurse at Florida Hospital and help children who are fighting the same battle that she did many years ago.
